On January 27th the U.S. Crescent alumni got together in Las Vegas, Nevada for a two day reunion that brought back old memories and created unforgettable new ones. Almost 90 alumni from all over the country and several more from India and UAE, poured in, double the number that had been originally expected. While a few hit the road in groups driving into Vegas most alumni flew in from cities across the United States - Washington DC, New York, Austin, Chicago, Phoenix to name a few. While some came to catch up with old friends and to make new friends, some came for professional networking, and most came to enjoy all three. No matter the reason, every alumnus made it a special all day fun filled reunion in Vegas.

As alumni checked in at New York Casino Hotel on Friday, January 27th, specially ordered reunion T-shirts were handed out. 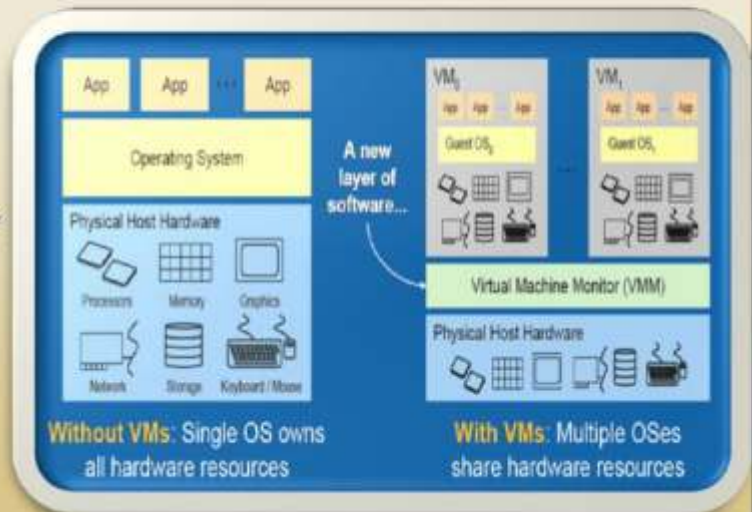

# STAFF OF THE MONTH



**Dr (Mrs) R.Vasanthakumari,**

Professor of Polymer Engg. Dept & Director, Polymer Nanotechnology Centre

## Sharing my thoughts and experience .....

It is indeed a great opportunity to serve this great institution for more than 16 years in Polymer Science and technology area. I joined as Professor and Head of the department of Polymer Technology on June 1, 2001 after serving for a period of 15 years (1986 to 2001) in a nylon tyre cord manufacturing industry, SRF Limited, Manali Plant, Chennai in R & D Centre and TQM Department.

I started my career as a Lecturer in Chemistry in 1970 after my post graduation (MSc) in Seethalakshmi Ramasamy College, Trichy. I worked for 5 years in my Alma mater along with my beloved Teachers and Mentors in Seethalakshmi Achi College, Pallathur. My research experience started with Dr Raman and Dr M K Sridhar in 1975 at Composites Lab, Materials Division,

Science, for 7 years (1977-1984) as Scientific Assistant and Technical Officer. While I was serving in IISc, I got a Reciprocal Research Fellowship through Government of India, Ministry of Education and Social Welfare to carry out research on Poly Lactic acid Crystallization studies for a period of one year (1979-1980) at State University of Groningen, Holland, under the supervision of

Eminent Professor Dr A J Pennings. This work formed the basis of my PhD research work on Crystallization of Polymers, basis of Fibre Industry at IISc from 1980 to 1984 under the guidance of Prof K Kishore, a Bhatnagar Awardee. For a short period of 2 years (1984-1986) I worked with Prof J Sobhanadri in Physics department of IIT Madras as CSIR Pool Officer in the area of polymers for microwave applications.

I was thrilled to see my name on 15 Aug 1986 in the newspapers announcing the President's National NRDC award for the work I did in NAL for two years, during 1975-1977. Also I was felicitated by the Management of SRF for getting the award. This unexpected award taught me one thing that if we keep on working without thinking about fruits, the fruits will themselves fall in our basket one day.

In addition to the above narrated varied research experience I had at various places, I cherish in my memory the great opportunities I had, to teach, to do research and consultancy work in two places namely SRF Ltd (15 years) and this Crescent institution (16 years). The experience I gained in Industry has given me lot of self confidence, courage, assertiveness in facing the challenges both in office and home front and to take initiatives and succeed in new things. In the meantime I also completed my MBA program (1995) and got trained in Total Quality Management at Osaka, Japan for one month (Dec 1998) by which I could provide my full support for implementation of TQM in SRF Ltd to get the prestigious Deming award.

After a gap of 26 years, when I was appointed in 2001 as Professor and Head of the department in this institution, by Dr K P Mohamed, Principal, Crescent Engineering College, it was a small department but a potential one. I had to face lot of challenges and difficulties. Compared to the other engineering disciplines, Polymer Engg. Department was not able to attract many students in spite of the hard and sincere



efforts put in by the faculty members. With the support and team work provided by the then young and energetic faculty members viz Dr K Ramamurthy, Abdul Kader, Abdul Majeed, Dr Amanulla, Nalini Uthaman, Sony George, Vasanthakumar, Bindu Sudhir, Abdullah, the B Tech Polymer Technology program secured 'A' Grade with 5 years of validity in 2002 and again in 2008 from NBA team of experts. This department was the only department at that time to get this grade by NBA that gave visibility and made everyone to have a keen watch.

was organized in 2010 by inviting industry personnel for all the engineering disciplines. EDC activities and Students' Inno Contests were also initiated and conducted with the support from all department faculty members.

It was a proud moment for me when I was honoured along with my PhD scholar S Vikram with a national award from Secretary, Ministry of chemicals and fertilizers, in April 2013 at New Delhi and with UG and PG students by Plast india Foundation in 2012.



We wanted to make a difference and be unique, so we started applying for Government funded sponsored research projects. The department facilities and infrastructure started improving year after year through the sanction of ~ Rs 205 Lakhs fund from various Govt. agencies like DRDO, NRB, AICTE, DIPAS, DST Nano mission and so on. Another mile stone has been the starting of a unique Centre for Polymer Nanotechnology inaugurated by Bharat Rathna Prof Dr CNR Rao on Aug 10, 2010. I wish to mention here that the continuous support, encouragement and motivation offered by Dr V M Periasamy and Correspondent Dr Peer Mohamed were worth mentioning and it inspired me to take more research initiatives in the department.

Dr P Kanniappan, the first Vice Chancellor of this University had great confidence in me and gave me additional assignments as "Director, Sponsored Project and Consultancy" from April 2009 to Nov. 2012 and "Director, Polymer Nanotechnology Centre" from May 2010. This helped me to initiate the process for obtaining funded projects from Govt. agencies for all the department faculties, of course, through the support of Dr V M Periasamy, Dr Sankaranarayanan and Dr P Kanniappan. While I was at industry my team was responsible for developing various new products and here at Crescent for developing quality manpower for further research and industries. I am very proud to mention that our Crescent Polymer alumni are wide spread all around the world in research institutions and in industries. It testifies to the quality and recognition of our program globally.

I thank Dr B S Abdur Rahman and our present beloved Chairman Abdur Qadir Rahman Buhari for providing me a safe and comfortable residence in the staff quarters when I was left alone due to the sudden demise of my husband Dr L Raju in Dec 2007. I am growing old physically but growing stronger and feeling younger in mind to bring up the young citizens of our country. I wish God gives me more energy to serve the humanity

Thus, I have the satisfaction of serving my best through different organizations and have given to the nation young and energetic persons to succeed me in the area of teaching and research. I thank the Almighty, my parents, my husband and my superiors of the organizations who have enabled me to grow along with them.

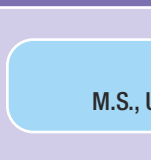
