My fascination only grew as I got older, and by the second grade, I'd written my first complete story. I dubbed it "Finny Edwardy Jacksony and the Journey to Usylandia," a title only a seven year old could conjure out of thin air. Practice makes perfect, and as I continued to write, my skill set expanded, giving me the ability to not only weave childish stories but to write essays and articles, such as this one.

By the fifth grade, I decided I wanted to be a writer when I grew up, an unconventional drift from my previous ideas of traveling the world, and running for President of the United States. And so, I did what writers did. I wrote a book.

It took a whole month, turning out to be just over a hundred pages in book format. Just the year before, I recall joking with my friends that I'd written a whole book once. They laughed along with me not believing, even for a moment, that I could have possibly accomplished such a feat. But here I was, a year later, reveling in the accomplishment of a feat I once thought impossible. Not without weeks of painstakingly attempting to come up with a title, I named my book The Warrior, and self-published it through CreateSpace, an Amazon subsidiary. AMEMORABLE JOURNEY WITHMY ALMA MATER

My first step into S.K.Crescent Engineering College was on 3.9.1985 as an undergraduate student. I came with my Dad to pay the fees as I got admission into this great institution. Before paying the fees we met Prof. S.Peer Mohamed at his residence to enquire as to how to reach the college. He immediately gave us a lift in his cab till Chetpet Railway station and also assigned a staff Mr. Chandrasekhar to accompany us. That was the first virtue of relative simplicity I learnt from Prof. S.Peer Mohamed, Principal of the college. We were taken around the college which had only three sheds as class rooms, a library, a workshop for carpentry& fitting and a smithy shop, a small staff room accommodating all the staff members and a canteen. The construction of a new building was in progress and they said that the students will be shifted to the new building. Since the

distance from my home to the college was around 40 kms, my dad thought that he would put me in the hostel. So we visited the ladies hostel which was a Hall with around 8 cots with three students and 4 teaching faculties. My dad did not approve of my stay in the hostel and so I commuted from Anna Nagar by bus from home to the Nungambakkam Railway station, by train from Nungambakkam to Tambaram and by college bus with a bus fare of Rs1/- from Tambaram to college.

On the first day (6.9.1985) to college, to attend classes I started from home by 6.45.a.m and reached Tambaram station by 8.00 am. Even though I had classes starting from 9.30a.m I reached Tambaram railway station by 8.00 am. I did not know what to do reaching so early so I got into the college bus. Scared of the ragging, I found a place near a professor and sat beside him. My seniors thought that I was known to the professor and so they did not rag me for the first week. Later they came to know my name and called me for ragging. The ragging was very mild like singing songs, counting the number of checks in the kerchief, telling a joke, etc., Later the seniors became close friends and almost all of us (first two batches) will travel together in a single compartment from Tambaram to our destination which is unforgettable. We had very good staff members who were very friendly and taught us everything that we had to learn. We used to walk through the mango grove through the crescent school to attend to physics and chemistry laboratories and also Engineering drawing Classes. The first semester which was supposed to begin by November got postponed due to heavy rains. So we had to write our first semester exams in April, 1986 and second semester during May 1986.

We were taken for the field visits to Ennore thermal power station, Ennore, Best and Crompton, Ambathur, Andrew Yule, Perungudi, Omega Cables, Ambathur Industrial Estate, High voltage department, CPRI Bangalore, Tuticorin thermal power plant, Tuticorin Harbor, WS Insulators, etc which helped us to understand the subjects better. When I completed my B.E from Crescent Engineering College, the first Muslim graduate and the first non-muslim graduate were placed in Mitsubishi Electric, Japan. I missed the opportunity as our director felt that since I was a girl I should be with the family and cannot go alone to Japan.

Hence I was given the opportunity to serve my

Alma mater and joined Crescent Engineering College as Teaching Assistant in the Electrical and Electronics Engineering department on 8.1.1990.It was very difficult for me to mingle with my faculty members as a co-staff member. Dr. Sheila. C. Haran,my class advisor and mentor and Mrs. Chaya Kulkarni, came to my rescue and trained me on how to prepare and take classes for the students. I was assisting them in the Laboratory classes in which I was good at. My LecturersMr. David Prabu Dayal Job, Mr. Aftab Ahmed Khan, Mr. Raghavendiran, Mr. Mubaraqali, Mr.Arif, Ms Lakshmi and the supporting staff Mr. Sadasivam, Mr. Jawahar ali, Mr.Azam, MrAsanar, MrN.Kumar were the most helpful and supported me during my tenure as

I was asked to be the General Secretary by Prof. Peer Mohamed and my work was to communicate to all alumni to make the association stronger.

I was promoted as Senior lecturer and transferred to ICE department in 1996. All my efforts were put in for developing the department since its inception, along with the Head of the department and faculty members, by framing the curriculum and syllabus and by setting up the Measurement and Instrumentation Lab, Control Lab, Process control Lab and Computing centre for the department. Meanwhile, in 1997 we started the student's International Professional society of ISA for which I was the faculty

teaching assistant. Even my classmates who came to visit the institution motivated me on doing service as a faculty in the department where I studied. Later my mentors imposed me on doing my PG to continue my teaching at Crescent. So I applied for PG at Anna University and got admission into M.E. Power Systems and after a week shifted to specialize in M.E. Control and Instrumentation.

I rejoined the Institution during July 1992, as Lecturer in the EEE department as a regular teaching faculty. My first task was to accompany the final yearEEE students for an Educational tour to Delhi, Shimla and Kulu Manali. The trip was memorable. That was the period I learnt how to deal with the student community and how a staff should communicate with the student. I was asked to be the faculty coordinator for National Level Technical Symposium - Cygnus 93 which was organized for the first time in the college. Later this experience made me the coordinator for many such symposiums and workshops held in the college. In the mean time Prof Peer Mohamed wanted me to start the alumni association. So I asked the 1996 batch students' willingness to join the association and we formed the association on 19.1.96 with 14 members out of which four of us were working for the Institution.

Many workshops and guest lectures were organized during my tenure as ISA faculty advisor. I was also responsible to organize the students First National symposium for ICE department -PRECISION + 98. Also I took the responsibility of the class advisor for the third batch ICE students in 1998. I arranged for at least three field visits every semester for the benefit of the students. Thus we were able to visit around 25 Industries in and around Chennai, South Indiaand Delhi. Even now my students (2001-ICE) recall about the number of industrial visits which improved their skills to gain more knowledge in Instrumentation and Control. All these were possible because of the able guidance of Dr. T.Thyagarajan, my Head of the department and Dr. K.P.Mohamed, Principal during the period 1997 - 2001.

When Dr. Sathik took over as Director, he asked me to expand the alumni association by registering all the outgoing students to become members of the alumni association by deducting Rs.1000/- from their caution deposit. So we formed the executive committee during the annual general body meeting and prepared the bylaws for the association. The alumni

association of Crescent Engineering College was formally registered in 2000 under the Tamilnadu Societies Registration Act,1975. From Dr. Sathik I obtained immense experience on how to do a work systematically in a stipulated time, on how to approach people and also on how to organize meetings etc.

As my passion was in Biomedical Engineering, I registered for research at AnnaUniversity and obtained doctoral degree in 2012. At this juncture I would like to thank Dr. T.R.Rangaswamy, Dr.T.Thyagarajan, Dr. Abdullah Khan, Dr. N.Bharathi, Dr. N.S.Bhuvaneswari, Dr. V.M.Periasamy, Dr. AngelinaGeetha, Mrs. Jwelcy, Dr. MannarJawahar, VC of Anna University, Dr. S.Ramakrishnan, Professor, IIT Madras and Mrs. Murshitha Shajahan, without whom I would not have completed my research.

I was assigned the duty of HoD In-charge in 2006 - 2007 for the Instrumentation and Control Engineering department and HoD from 2011-12 and 2013-2016 for Electronics and Instrumentation Engineering (as the department was renamed when the college became University). During my tenure as HoD my teachers Dr. I.Mohamed Bilal, Dr. Basheer Ahamed, Dr. S.Rajasekar, Mrs.P.Taj Begum, Dr. I. Shameem Banu, Dr. Shahin Sulthana, Dr.Usharani, Dr. Prince Arokiadoss, Dr. Rasool Mohideen, Dr. Sheik Abdul Kader, and Mr. Chandran, gave their blessings and motivated me, for whom I am indebted to.

With all the knowledge and experience gained from my Alma mater I would proudly say that the tasks carried out by me was to form the

- 1. Alumni Association of Crescent Engineering College (1996) and serving as General Secretary from 1996 2003.
- 2. ISA Students Chapter (1997) and serving as faculty advisor (1997 2003)
- 3. ISTE Chapter Crescent Engineering College (1994) and serving as executive member (1993-1995)

4. Coordinator, Value added Programme on Industrial Automation (2014)

I was also given the opportunity for organizing Two national Conferences (2001, 2012), One faculty development Programme (2007), and a number of workshops for the benefit of the student community and faculty members, organizing industrial training for the students and faculty during vacation, organizing guest lectures, setting up laboratories with fellow faculty members for the department, coordinating students technical symposiums, open house for the department, motivating the supporting faculty members to attend skill development programme at other institutions, organizing workshop for technicians of the university on control valves and its characteristics, preparing curriculum and syllabus for M.Tech Electronics and Instrumentation Engineering when it was started in 2010. As a part of social activity of the department I arranged and took the EIE students for Ethical Voting and Beach Cleaning in 2014 and Beach cleaning in 2015. I also had the opportunity to serve as the Joint secretary for the staff club for two years (1999, 2000).

The optimistic philosophy has been much solace to me in my own journey in becoming a successful CRESCENTIAN now. Although at certain points the bumps could seem as high as mountains and the pits as deep as lots, making this journey appear sometimes despondent. It was not all that easy, although it was my patience, skills and with all my well wishers both my teachers and the students that tended my journey towards reaching higher goals and move forward by learning from the past oversight.

I take this opportunity to thank almighty and each and every soul in my journey for molding me for who I am now and the members of the association for giving me an opportunity to share my pleasant experience.
